2. The third party must obtain all necessary permits, licenses and other approvals prior to their event.
3. Pre-approval by Shelter Nova Scotia of all marketing is mandatory - this includes but is not limited to social media posts, logo use, scripts, remarks, media releases etc.
4. Any media interviews or quotes regarding the event must be preapproved by Shelter Nova Scotia – contact jaymebutt@shelternovascotia.com
5. Shelter Nova Scotia is not responsible for any injury or damage to persons or property that may occur during the event or fundraising.
6. The third party must abide by and observe all applicable laws, rules, regulations and ordinances of government authorities.
7. Proceeds from the fundraising should be paid to Shelter Nova Scotia within 30 days of the event.
8. Shelter Nova Scotia is only able to provide tax receipts if the fundraising organizer and the Shelter Nova Scotia representative have discussed this prior to the event. This is to ensure that all Canada Revenue Agency regulations related to issuing charitable tax receipts are being followed.
9. Shelter Nova Scotia is unable to provide financial assistance to third parties who are fundraising on our behalf.
10. Support and participation by Shelter Nova Scotia staff and/or volunteers is voluntary and limited to available resources.
11. Shelter Nova Scotia may withdraw the right to use its name and cancel this third party agreement within 24 hours' notice if it has serious concerns about the activities of the third party. Shelter Nova Scotia will not be responsible for financial or other damages that may result from this cancellation.
